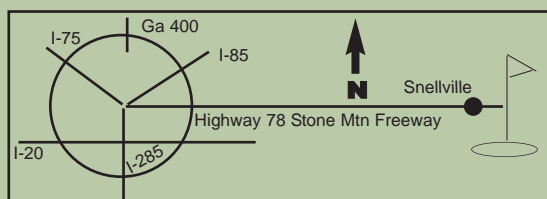
## *Amenities*

If you prefer to make a racket with a tennis racket, then we have twelve courts waiting for your arrival. We also provide two pools for recreation, exercise and competitive youth programs. If you need a comfortable and relaxing place to enjoy fine dining or a casual meal, then Summit Chase is the place for you. ## *Location*

We are conveniently located near the intersection of U.S. Highway 78 and Rosebud Road approximately 3.5 miles from Snellville City Hall. This makes us easily accessible from Gwinnett, Dekalb, Rockdale, and Walton counties.

A current schedule of initiation fees, dues and club by-laws is located in the back of this booklet.

Applications are available by calling 770-979-9000. Membership application and agreement must be submitted in person to the club office. In addition to applicable initiation fee, the first two months dues must be paid in advance.

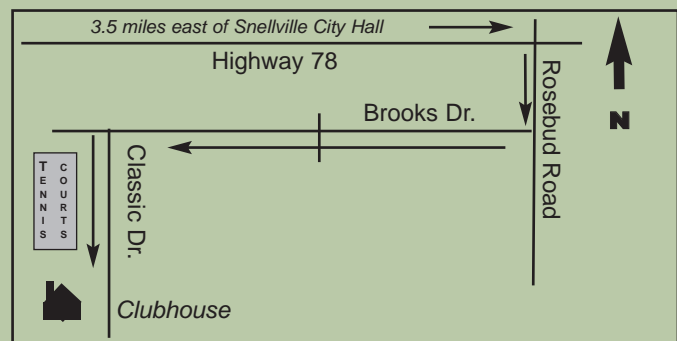
## *Membership Classifications*

**Full** - Family access to all golf, tennis, swimming and dining facilities, as well as all social functions.

**Senior** - Family access (family must include at least one primary member age 60 or over), to all golf, tennis, swimming, and dining facilities, as well as all social functions.

**Junior** - Family access (family must include at least one primary member under the age of 30), access to all golf, tennis, swimming and dining facilities, as well as all social functions.

**Social** - Family access to all tennis, swimming and dining facilities, as well as all social functions. In addition, this membership allows limited golf privileges as follows: Tuesday through Thursday for member green fee of \$10.00 plus cart, and Friday through Sunday and holidays for the standard guest green fee. Driving range privileges are only available as you pay green fees on a daily basis. Social members are not allowed to participate in the handicap system, nor are they allowed to play in Summit Chase golf tournaments.



# SUMMIT CHASE

Corporate - A Corporate Membership allows four families access to all golf, tennis, swimming, and dining facilities, as well as all social functions. All primary members must be employed by the corporation. The corporation is responsible for all dues, fees and club charges. Individual accounts may be set up for personal charges. Additional members may be added to the corporate membership and the dues will be pro rated based on the monthly structure.

This is a great and inexpensive way for a business to allow its employees to utilize the facilities at the club. It is also the only membership category that is transferable. For example, if an employee leaves the corporation, his or her replacement may be substituted onto the corporate membership with no additional fee. This may occur up to four times with no additional fee.

Dining - Family access to the dining room, lounge and all social functions.

Summer Pool - Family access to both pools and dining facilities from Memorial Day until Labor Day. Club charge privileges are not given to summer pool members.

## Additional Information

All family memberships include the primary member, spouse and children up to age 25.

All golf memberships must pay an initiation fee.

The Driving Range fee on all golf memberships is included in the monthly dues.

All dues are paid monthly except Dining and Summer Pool, which are paid annually.

All memberships, except Summer Pool, carry a \$25.00 monthly minimum food & beverage purchase requirement. All food & beverage purchases made by cash, club credit or bank charge accounts

during the month will be applied toward your monthly minimum requirement. Tax and gratuity charges are not considered food and beverage purchases. If you do not meet the \$25.00 minimum, the remaining balance up to \$25.00 will be charged to your account for the month. Minimums are calculated concurrent with our billing cycle, the 26th through the 25th of the following month. Only purchases made during the current month are applied to the current month's minimum. Carry-overs are not allowed.

All club facilities are closed on Monday except on holidays.



# GOLF

## *Golf Course*

Summit Chase has a well respected 18-hole championship golf course. The golf course encompasses 180 beautiful acres of rolling hills and tree lined fairways that offer a challenge for golfers of all skill levels. The club's bermuda fairways and bent grass greens make for a well conditioned venue for every golfer's enjoyment. Summit Chase has been recognized for its excellence by the Georgia State Golf Association by hosting two State 4-Ball Championships and a State Mid-Amateur Championship, as well as an Atlanta Amateur Championship. Summit Chase has been host to several qualifiers for the State Amateur Championship, State Open Championship and the PGA Club Professional Championship.



The Summit Chase Golf Programs are run under the leadership of a Head Golf Professional, Assistant Golf Professionals, and an Outside Services Coordinator.

## *Men's Golf*

The Men's Golf Program at Summit Chase is very active. We have a tournament schedule that runs year round and there are several groups of regular social golfers that offer a game for any skill level throughout the week and on weekends. We play a dogfight every Saturday, and hold a Beat the Pro quarterly.

Our popular Senior Men's Golf Program holds a dogfight on Tuesday morning and a play day on Wednesday morning. The season runs from March until November and includes a variety of games and great tournaments.

## *Ladies' Golf*

The Ladies' Golf Program features a play day on Thursday morning and Saturday afternoon. The LGP tournament schedule runs from March until October and offers opportunities to play a variety of games. All ladies, from beginner to advanced, are welcome.



## *Couples' Golf*

The Couples' Golf Program features play days with a variety of fun games each Sunday afternoon. Couples' tournaments run March through October and offer a great opportunity to enjoy your game together.

## *Family Golf*

Summit Chase proudly offers a set of Family Tees on each hole. These shorter tees allow junior players of all ages to enjoy the game of golf, feel competitive with the family, and learn the fundamentals of the game without being overwhelmed. Junior score-cards are available for each round in the golf shop. Family events are hosted regularly throughout the season.



## *Junior Golf*

Instruction, competition and fun are available year round in our Junior Golf Program. Whether you are looking for group clinics, private lessons, or a challenging match, you will find the best at Summit Chase. Additionally, juniors have the opportunity once each month to play with one of the Summit Chase professionals in a 'Play with the Pro' event. All of our programs are fully staffed with PGA Professionals who are qualified to teach the ins and outs of the game while making it enjoyable for the entire family.

Summit Chase has supported Junior Golf in the community by hosting three Gwinnett County High School teams for over 25 years. We are proud to host many AJGA, Southeast Junior and U. S. Kids events and look forward to our continued association with these quality junior golf organizations.

## *Lessons/Clinics*

Our professional staff is happy to assist golfers of all ages and skill levels through private lessons or group instruction. The fee for private lessons for adults is \$40.00 per ½ hour and for juniors, the fee is \$20.00 per ½ hour.

## *Golf Pro Shop*

The Summit Chase Golf Shop carries the finest in equipment and apparel for all golfers. We stock golf apparel for men, ladies and juniors as well as the highest quality of equipment at the most competitive prices around. If there is a special item you would like to own, we are happy to place an order for you. Additionally, we offer a shoeshine service and light maintenance such as spike change, club re-gripping, and minor club repair.



# TENNIS

## *Where Tennis is More Than an Aside*

Remember the days when those who had a passion for tennis could belong to a club that took the game as seriously as they did? Believe it or not, that culture still exists at Summit Chase. Our commitment to the game of tennis has never faltered or compromised.

The evidence of that commitment is clear in a tennis facility that includes 12 lighted tennis courts, three of which are clay. The courts are situated in three different locations on the property, giving ample opportunity for everyone to enjoy the club's tennis program.

## *Team Tennis*

Summit Chase participates in both ALTA and USTA. We offer team tennis year round at all levels of play for each age category. We provide team coaching for men, women, and children during both ALTA and USTA seasons. Team coaching consists of one hour per week of group instruction for 8-10 weeks using 1-3 coaches. Coaching is provided for all levels of play from beginning to advanced. Costs vary depending on the number of weeks and the number of players on each team.

## *Social Tennis*

Summit Chase offers Interclub tennis for men and women in the fall and spring, and mixed doubles in the summer. These popular leagues last eight weeks and are a great way to meet other members and play competitive matches without the inconvenience of traveling. In addition, we offer a very active social tennis schedule that includes holiday social functions, Friday night round robins, and special events.

## *Junior Drills and Team Coaching*

Junior Tennis at Summit Chase is more active than ever. We offer year round advanced and intermediate drills. The advanced program is geared toward tournament level and high school level players. This is for serious year-round players. Advanced drills are held three days per week for 1 ½ hours, and intermediate drills are two days per week for 1 hour. In addition to drills, one-hour team coaching is available one day per week for beginner and intermediate players during the ALTA and USTA seasons.

## *Junior Tennis Camps*

Tennis Camps are offered throughout the summer for beginner and intermediate players. Each camp session is four days, (Tuesday through Friday), for 1 to 1 ½ hours depending on age and skill level. Pee Wee Camps are also offered during the summer and at various times during the year for entry level children under the age of eight. A four day tennis camp for all levels is offered during the Gwinnett County School System spring break.



## *Junior Interclub*

Junior interclub is a six week league, free of charge, that is held three times during the year: spring, summer and fall. It combines match play and strategy with fun games to help beginner and intermediate players in match situations. One or more coaches are on the court during the set to teach and correct situations as they happen. This important time of instruction, combined with the ease of playing all the matches at home, makes this a fun learning experience.

## *Private Lessons*

Private lessons are available on an individual or small group basis for adults and children on Tuesday through Sunday. The cost is \$22.00 per half-hour or \$44.00 per hour.



## *Tennis Pro Shop*

The Summit Chase Tennis Shop offers a variety of mens' and ladies' apparel and equipment at competitive prices. Our shop professionals can also re-string or re-grip your rackets. The shop hours are 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Tuesday through Sunday.

# SOCIAL

## *Social Events and Dining*

Summit Chase has offered excellent service to the community for over 30 years and our attention to detail has kept our friends coming back. We have an excellent chef and staff to make your dining experience unforgettable. Our professional staff has decades of combined service experience.

## *Member Dining*

The Dining Room features several opportunities for both fine and casual dining throughout the week. Lunch is served Tuesday through Saturday. Additionally, we host patio service during the summer season (mid-May through mid-September). We serve a traditional Brunch every Sunday. A buffet dinner is served each Wednesday evening. We offer dining from our popular Lounge Menu each Tuesday and Thursday evening.

On Friday evening, we feature a fine dining atmosphere a la carte. Our chef will delight you each week as new specialty entrees, sides and desserts are introduced on our dinner menu. The dress code in the Dining Room on Friday evening is business casual, and no denim clothing or athletic attire is allowed. Attire worn on the golf course is permitted. There are no exceptions to this rule.

## *Member Special Events*

We host many special events throughout the year such as: Seafood Buffet, Prime Rib Dinner, an exciting New Year's Eve Party, Casino Night, Dinner Theater, Wine Tasting, and fun-filled pool parties for Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day.

In addition to our special events, we also host private functions at a discounted room rate for our members. These functions include corporate holiday parties, wedding receptions, anniversary or retirement parties, class reunions, and luncheons of all kinds.

## *Reservation Policy*

Reservations are recommended for all dining events at Summit Chase, and must be cancelled 48 hours in advance of all special functions.



## *The Lounge*

Our lounge is open Tuesday through Sunday. Alcoholic beverages are sold on Sunday after 12:30 pm. We offer both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, as well as a variety of snacks, cold sandwiches, hot dogs, and popcorn. Since all food and beverage must be purchased through Summit Chase, we offer coolers filled with your beverage of choice to take out on the course, the courts, or poolside.

Friday evenings in the Lounge are full of excitement. In addition to our a la carte dinner, we offer live entertainment from local musicians or D. J. entertainment. On D. J. Friday, we also play America's favorite card game, Texas Hold 'Em. The music is always great and there is plenty of room on the dance floor for you!

## *Lounge Dining*

The Lounge offers dining on Tuesday and Thursday evenings for a weeknight bonus. We also offer the a la carte menu on Friday night with the casual atmosphere of the lounge. In addition to grab n' go snacks, candy bars, hot dogs and cold sandwiches, our lunch menu is also offered in the lounge during the same hours lunch is served in the dining room. Reminder: seating in the lounge is always for ages 21 and over.

# SWIM

Summit Chase has two beautiful, crystal blue swimming pools. Our free-form pool is primarily used for young children and adults. The 25-meter junior olympic pool is used for recreation as well as competitive swimming. Lifeguards are always on duty during open swim. The summer swim season opens in mid-May and closes on Labor Day. The pool is open daily Tuesday through Sunday.

We also offer a snack bar at the aquatics facility. The snack bar is open Tuesday through Sunday during the summer swim season and offers a variety of snacks and drinks.

## *Summer League Swim Team*

Our summer swim team competes in the Gwinnett County Swim League. A head coach runs this program, along with several assistant coaches and a parent board. Registration begins in March and runs through June 1. Evening practices begin in mid-May. The series of six swim meets starts early in June with the county meet taking place in July. Children ages 4 through 18 are invited to participate in this great summer program.



## *Year Round Swimming*

The Summit Chase year round swim team competes in the United States Swimming League and has been in existence since 1993. Our staff of professional coaches provides superb instruction and has produced many nationally ranked swimmers as well as several Olympic hopefuls.

## *Swim Lessons*

Summit Chase offers one of the finest swim lesson programs in the state. Our Director and staff of professional coaches provide year round\* instruction in a safe and comfortable small group environment. Weekday sessions are made up of eight ½ hour lessons. Separate Friday evening and Saturday afternoon lessons are offered as well. Discounts are given for multiple swimmers in the same family. We also offer a four session, Saturday afternoon stroke clinic in April as preparation for our summer swim league.

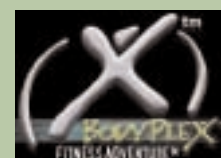
*\*Lessons are not given during the months of December and January.*

## Summit Chase Membership Categories

### **FULL FAMILY**

**\$260 per month**

Membership includes family access to all golf, tennis, swim, dining and social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **FULL INDIVIDUAL GOLF**

**\$195 per month**

Membership includes family access to all tennis, swim, dining and social functions. Allows golf and range access for one member of the family. Additional members of the family may play golf with the payment of a guest fee. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **SENIOR**

**\$195 per month**

Primary member must be 60 years of age or over. Membership includes family access to golf, tennis, swim, dining and social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **YOUNG EXECUTIVE**

**\$195 per month**

Primary member must be between the ages of 26 - 35. Membership includes family access to golf, tennis, swim, dining and social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **ASSOCIATE**

**\$135 per month**

Primary member must be between the ages of 21- 25. Membership includes family access to golf, tennis, swim, dining and social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **SOCIAL**

**\$135 per month**

Membership includes family access to all tennis, swim, dining and social functions. Social membership allows limited golf access. A member green fee is required to play golf. The driving range may be used when the member green fee is paid. Tournament and golf handicap participation are not permitted. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **TENNIS & SWIM FAMILY**

**\$100 per month**

Membership includes family access to all tennis, swim, dining and social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **TENNIS & SWIM INDIVIDUAL**

**\$75 per month**

Membership includes access to all tennis, swim, dining and social functions to one individual. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **DINING**

**\$300 Annually**

Membership includes family access to dining room, lounge and all social functions. A \$25 per month food and beverage minimum is required.

### **YOUTH GOLF**

**\$900 Annually**

Member must be between the age of 12 - 21 and full time student. Annual dues are \$900 and may be paid annually or semi-annually. Certification by a Summit Chase PGA professional is required for unaccompanied play. Tee times may be booked 24 hours in advance, and after 2:00 p.m. on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays. A valid driver's license is required and must be kept on file for golf cart rental. Charging privileges are determined by parent and require a valid credit card on file for club purchases. A food and beverage minimum does not apply.

### **SUMMER SWIM AND DINE**

**\$600 One Summer Season**

Membership Includes family access to swim and dining facilities from Memorial Day until Labor Day. Club charge privileges are not given to summer swim and dine members.

**CORPORATE**

**\$780 per month**

Membership includes access to golf, tennis, swim, dining and social functions for four (4) families with at least one member of each family employed by the corporation. The corporation is responsible for payment of all dues. Club charge accounts may be set up for each individual with the corporation guaranteeing the payment.

Food & Beverage Minimum	\$25/month per family
Additional Corporate Members (above four)	\$125 per month each

**CORPORATE CONNECTION**

**\$500 Annually**

Membership includes access to golf, dining and social functions for up to five (5) individuals employed by the corporation. Additional employees may be added to the membership for an additional \$50 dollars up to a maximum of ten. Corporation is responsible for payment of all dues, charges, and minimums. No individual charging privileges will be permitted. All club charging must be made to the corporate account or individuals may use cash or credit card.

This membership is designed to give access to the golf course, dining room, meeting room space (at no extra charge) and social functions in order to help promote your business or reward your employees without the commitment of monthly dues.

All golf access will be at the standard guest rates. Tee times will be available at any time Tuesday - Friday and after 12:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. Swimming and Tennis privileges are not included in the Corporate Connection Membership.

A ten percent discount will be given for dues paid annually and a five percent discount will be given for dues paid on a semi-annual basis.

Summit Chase members are not locked into a long-term commitment and can easily exit the club if needed. After a one year commitment of membership, the club simply requires a 30 day written notice to terminate membership. Members are responsible for applicable dues and charges during the 30 day notice period and no refund of any pre-paid fees, including dues, will be made if a member elects to resign.

Members can change membership classifications, but must stay at the new classification for at least one year before changing again. Upgrading to certain classifications may require payment of an entry fee.

Applications for membership will be reviewed by club management. No membership shall become effective until accepted by the club and all applicable fees and charges have been paid.

All family memberships include a primary member, spouse and all children up to age 25.

All members are required to keep a valid credit card on file.

All club dues, fees, by-laws and benefits are subject to change.

# BY-LAWS

PLEASE READ THE BY-LAWS THOROUGHLY. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH CLUB MEMBER TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE BY-LAWS CONTAINED HEREIN.

## CLUBHOUSE BY-LAWS

It is the responsibility of club members to know and abide by the club By-laws.

1. Proper attire must be worn at all times. Swim suits are not considered Proper attire.
2. No one under 18 years of age will be allowed in the locker rooms at any time unless accompanied by his or her parents.
3. Clubhouse telephones are for adult use. A phone is provided at the pool concession stand.
4. Children will not be allowed to loiter in the clubhouse at any time. Children are not allowed at club without supervision.
5. Following the completion of a one-year agreement, member may terminate membership with a 30 day advance written notice. Owner of club may terminate membership at its sole discretion by giving 30 day written notice to member.
6. Dinner reservations must be cancelled 48 hours prior to the event or member will be billed for event.
7. Food & beverage purchased elsewhere are not permitted on club grounds or golf course. No personal coolers are permitted on club grounds or golf course.
8. No one under 21 allowed in lounge.
9. Violations of club by-laws may result in temporary or permanent suspension of membership privileges.

## GOLF-BY-LAWS

The Golf Professional, or his designated assistants in his absence, shall have full charge of the golf course and shall be the first authority as to the interpretation or enforcement of the following Rules:

1. All members and guests are required to register in the golf shop before playing.
2. Golf carts may not be operated by anyone without a valid drivers license. Each cart is limited to two bags and two persons.
3. All carts should be kept on the cart paths around all tees and greens and should be kept on the paths, when "Cart Path Only" signs are posted on the first tee. Violation of this rule carries an automatic \$25.00 fine for the first offense and suspension of cart privileges for the second offense.
4. Proper attire must be worn at all times. Cut-offs, swim suits, denim shorts or slacks, tank tops, or t-shirts are not considered proper golf attire.
5. All players are required to have their own bag and clubs. If spiked golf shoes are worn they must be non-metal spikes.
6. Members will be charged for any damage done to a golf cart.
7. Children under the age of 12 are not allowed on the golf course, practice tee or practice green unless accompanied by an adult or certified by the Golf Professional.
8. There will be no fivesomes allowed on weekends or holidays or when the golf course is crowded. Tuesday through Friday fivesomes will be allowed to play with permission of the Golf Professional Staff.
9. There will be no mulligans on week-ends or holidays.
10. SLOW PLAY. If a group falls out of position, they will be asked to pick up the pace. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to step aside and let faster groups play through.
11. Starting on #10 is not allowed without permission from the golf shop. The back nine is never open until 9:00 a.m. during weekdays.
12. Proper safety and common sense must prevail on the practice tee. No one is allowed on the driving range to retrieve balls already hit.
13. Call in day for weekend tee times is Thursday at 7:30 a.m. Tee times are required for weekdays. You may call one week in advance for week-day tee times. Failure to notify the Golf Shop of any tee time cancellation at least 24 hours in advance will be subject to a fine.
14. Food & beverage purchased outside the premises is not allowed.

Bottled beverages are never allowed on the course.

15. Members who sign up for any golf event and do not cancel within 24 hours will be charged the appropriate fee plus golf cart fee.
16. REMEMBER: Golf is a gentleman's game where courtesy and good etiquette should always be observed. This includes repairing ball marks, kicking in divots, picking up broken tees, etc.
17. A score must be returned for every 18 hole round played at the club. If one is not returned, a penalty score will be posted. That score will be 10 strokes below your handicap.
18. The golf course, putting green and practice facility are CLOSED on Monday.

## SWIMMING BY-LAWS

1. All persons, while in the swimming pool area, must obey the directions of the life guards.
2. Swimmers must be attired in regular swim suits. (No cut-offs or frayed material)
3. The free-form pool is our recreational pool, and the lower pool is used for both recreation and our various junior aquatic programs.
4. Running, shouting, screaming, boisterous play or splash dives are not permitted.
5. No glass or metal containers are allowed within the pool area.
6. Pool furniture is not allowed outside the pool area and should be treated with care.
7. Children are required to use the rest room facilities at the pool. No one under age 18 is allowed in the locker rooms unless accompanied by a parent.
8. All persons are required to use waste receptacles placed around the pool area.
9. No pets allowed in pool area.
10. Children 10 years of age and younger will not be allowed in pool area unless escorted by a responsible adult.
11. All persons entering the pool area must register with lifeguard on duty. All guests must be accompanied by a member and pay a guest fee. Out of town guests can obtain a pass from the office.
12. No food will be allowed in the pool area. No personal coolers are permitted in pool area.
13. Members and their children are subject to loss of pool privileges if the above rules are not observed.

## TENNIS COURT BY-LAWS

1. Reservations will be made through pro shop 48 hours in advance. Reservations for Tuesday may be made beginning at 9:00 a.m. Sunday.
2. As a courtesy to other members, if you cannot keep your court reservations, please cancel as soon as possible. Repeated offenders will be subject to losing their reservation privileges.
3. There will be a 15 minute holding time for court reservations, after 15 minutes, the court will be open.
4. There will be a hour and a half reservation time per court except for ALTA matches, tournament play, lessons and Club scheduled functions.
5. Play for Juniors under 18 will be restricted to courts 7 and 8, Monday thru Friday until 6:00 p.m. These may be reserved for up to a hour and a half and juniors cannot be bumped by adults.
6. No one allowed on courts except players, instructors or officiating personnel.
7. No food, no beverage, other than WATER, and no smoking at any time allowed on courts.
8. All guests must register in the tennis shop prior to play.
9. Proper attire is required on the tennis courts at all times. No swimming attire or cut off shorts are allowed. Shirts and regulation tennis shoes must be worn on the court at all times.
