BY-LAWS



PLEASE READ THE BY-LAWS THOROUGHLY. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH CLUB MEMBER TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE BY-LAWS CONTAINED HEREIN.

CLUBHOUSE BY-LAWS

1. Proper attire must be worn at all times. Inside the clubhouse, cover-ups must be worn over swim suits.
2. Children under 18 years of age are permitted in the locker rooms only when accompanied by a parent or adult.
3. Clubhouse telephones are for adult use. A phone is provided in the front reception area and at the pool snack bar.
4. Children may not loiter in the clubhouse at any time. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times while on club property.
5. Following the completion of a one-year agreement, member may terminate membership with a 30 day advance written notice. Club management may terminate membership at its sole discretion by giving a 30 day written notice to member.
6. Dinner reservations must be cancelled 48 hours prior to the event or member will be billed for event.
7. Food & beverages purchased elsewhere are not permitted on club grounds or golf course. Personal coolers are not permitted on club grounds or golf course.
8. Children under age 21 are permitted to eat lunch in the lounge.
9. Violations of club by-laws may result in temporary or permanent suspension of membership privileges.

GOLF BY-LAWS

The Golf Professional, or his designated assistants in his absence, shall have full charge of the golf course and shall be the first authority as to the interpretation or enforcement of the following rules:

1. All members and guests are required to register in the golf shop before playing.
2. Golf carts may not be operated by anyone without a valid driver's license. Each cart is limited to two bags and two persons.
3. All carts should be kept on the cart paths around all tees and greens and should be kept on the paths, when "Cart Path Only" signs are posted on the first tee. Violation of this rule carries an automatic \$25.00 fine for the first offense and suspension of cart privileges for the second offense.
4. Proper attire must be worn at all times. Cut-offs, swim suits, denim shorts or slacks, tank tops, or t-shirts are not considered proper golf attire.
5. All players are required to have their own bag and clubs. Only soft spikes or spikeless golf shoes are permitted.
6. Members will be charged for any damage done to a golf cart.
7. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted on the golf course, practice tee or practice green unless accompanied by an adult or certified by the Golf Professional.
8. There will be no fivesomes permitted on weekends or holidays or when the golf course is crowded. Tuesday through Friday fivesomes will be permitted to play with permission of the Golf Professional Staff.
9. Mulligans will be permitted on weekdays only, holidays excluded.
10. SLOW PLAY: if a group falls out of position, they will be asked to pick up the pace. Failure to do so will result in them being asked to step aside to allow faster groups to play through.
11. Starting on #10 is not permitted without authorization from the golf shop. The back nine will open before 9:00 a.m. on weekdays.
12. Proper safety and common sense must prevail on the practice tee. On the driving range, no one is permitted to retrieve balls already hit.
13. For weekend tee times, phone the golf shop on Thursday at 7:30 a.m. Tee times are required for weekdays. You may call one week in advance for weekday tee times. If you fail to notify the golf shop of any tee time cancellation at least 24 hours in advance, you will be subject to a fine.
14. Food & beverages purchased outside the premises are not permitted. Glass containers are not permitted on the course.
15. Members who sign up for any golf event and do not cancel

- within 24 hours will be charged the appropriate fee plus golf cart fee.
16. REMEMBER: golf is a 'Gentleman's Game' where courtesy and good etiquette should always be observed. This includes repairing ball marks, kicking in divots, picking up broken tees, etc.
17. A score must be returned for every 18 hole round played at the club. If one is not returned, a penalty score will be posted. That score will be equal to the lowest differential in the player's scoring record.
18. The golf course, putting green and practice facility are CLOSED on Monday.

TENNIS COURT BY-LAWS

1. Reservations will be made through the tennis shop 48 hours in advance. Reservations for Tuesday may be made beginning at 9:00 a.m. Sunday.
2. As a courtesy to other members, if you cannot keep your court reservations, please cancel as soon as possible. Repeat offenders will be subject to losing their reservation privileges.
3. There will be a 15 minute holding time for court reservations; after 15 minutes, the court will be open to other players.
4. There will be a one and a half hour reservation time per court except for ALTA matches, tournament play, lessons and scheduled club functions.
5. Play for juniors under age 18 will be restricted to courts 7 and 8, Monday through Friday until 6:00 p.m. These may be reserved for up to one and a half hours and juniors cannot be bumped by adults.
6. No one is permitted on the courts except players, instructors or persons officiating.
7. Smoking is prohibited at any time on the courts.
8. All guests must register in the tennis shop prior to play.
9. Proper attire is required on the tennis courts at all times. No swimming attire or cut-off shorts are allowed. Shirts and regulation tennis shoes must be worn on the court at all times.

SWIMMING BY-LAWS

1. All persons, while in the swimming pool area, must obey the directions of the lifeguards.
2. Swimmers must be attired in regular swim suits; no cut-offs or frayed material.
3. The upper pool is our recreational pool, and the lower pool is used for both recreation and our various junior aquatic programs.
4. Running, shouting, screaming, boisterous play or splash dives are not permitted.
5. No glass or metal containers are permitted within the pool area.
6. Pool furniture is not permitted outside the pool area and should be treated with care.
7. Children are encouraged to use the restroom facilities at the pool. Children under age 18 are permitted to use the locker rooms when accompanied by an adult.
8. All persons are required to use waste receptacles placed around the pool area.
9. Pets are strictly forbidden in the pool area.
10. Children 10 years of age and younger will not be permitted in pool area unless escorted by a responsible adult.
11. All persons entering the pool area must register with the lifeguard on duty. All guests must be accompanied by a member and pay a guest fee. Out of town guests can obtain a pass from the office.
12. Food & beverages purchased outside the premises are not permitted. No personal coolers are permitted in the pool area. All food purchased from the club or snack bar must be consumed either on the back deck or the snack bar deck. Food consumption is strictly prohibited on the pool deck.
13. Members and their children are subject to the loss of pool privileges if the above rules are not observed.
