### QUICKSTART TENNIS CAMP

USTA's Quickstart program uses foam balls or low compression tennis balls to get an age (and size) appropriate bounce for juniors aged 4-12. Temporary nets are also placed lengthwise on the court into four sections allowing the players to play four matches at a time per court. This camp is offered to the novice pee-pee and beginner players for six consecutive weeks on Saturday.

### TENNIS DRILLS

These drills are held twice per week on Tuesday and Thursday 4:30 - 6:00 pm during the school year for a monthly fee of \$125.00. These drills are for intermediate to advanced players and are coached by the Director of Tennis, John Heitkam and Tennis Professional, Rob Hrehor. The drills are low intensity and emphasize proper strokes, footwork, and strategy through drills and match play. Placement is determined by a player evaluation with John Heitkam.

### TENNIS ACADEMY

Tennis Academy is offered year-round by invitation from the Tennis Academy Director, Steve Hill. Tennis Academy is held four days per week, Tuesday through Friday 3:45 - 5:45 pm for advanced elite, and 5:45 - 7:30 for intermediate advanced. When school is out these two are combined and offered Tuesday through Friday, 11:30 am - 1:30 pm. You may choose the following levels of participation in any combination of days:

<u>Two days per week</u>	16 hours of instruction \$150.00 per month
<u>Three days per week</u>	24 hours of instruction \$175.00 per month
<u>Four days per week</u>	32 hours of instruction \$210.00 per month

*Players in the Academy are offered a discount on private lessons.*
